### Licensing Information from call that is not in a PIN

- Closures – CCL does not have the authority to close private facilities, operators should read local Shelter in Place orders or local Health Department Guidance to find out if child care is permitted. If there is no local, state or federal restrictions on child care, the closure is at the discretion of the operators. Please adhere to California Department of Health Guidelines.
- Cleaning and Sanitation Supplies - There may be funds to assist with protective gear and sanitization supplies, please submit requests to This e-mail address is: [CCLCOVID-19INFO@dss.ca.gov](mailto:CCLCOVID-19INFO@dss.ca.gov)
- Workforce Needs - Closing your facility is case-by-case. If your facility closes staff might choose to work in a pop-up site or at a facility that is open and needs staff. Contact Choices for Children for workforce needs.
- Prioritizing Care that is offered - You can make the decision to close. If you do a pop-up you can refer individuals who need the pop-up. Licensing says yes given this situation you can prioritize and ask some to stay home and only serve first responders and health care officials.
